The clients' brief to Chris Morrison of Morriarchi Architecture was to create a building with the 'WOW' factor. In response, architect Chris Morrison – himself a keen surfer - drew inspiration from the ocean to design an architectural masterpiece incorporating generous entertaining areas, plenty of natural sunlight, clean lines, and a wave-like façade created by the contours of the roof and wall.

The monolithic shape of the building's façade is reflective of the breaking surf which can be viewed in all its glory from the home's upper-level balcony and pool terrace. The home also features an impressive array of luxurious inclusions, such as a state-of-the-art electronic driving range, pool, sauna, a 4 hole putting green, huge home theatre and, perhaps most delightfully, a teppanyaki bar.
